Dear WCC member,

Over the past year and two months, We have had the privelgde in getting to know each of you. A few weeks ago we had the opportunity to share with you all our heart for Haiti. You heard about our ministry Bezelel Movement and how we have been working with youth and leading them to Christ through a variety of ways. You also had a chance to learn about the new project we have underway in the community of Maplat. The community that suffers from extreme poverty and live without the daily necessities including the lack of water, education, healthcare and spiritual guidance.

Remember when we said that since 2008 we have been bringing local Haitian youth and mission teams from abroad to this segregated community? And how God has laid it upon our hearts to build a community centre that will benefit this village in more ways than one? A place where the locals can turn to for help. A place to get constant medical care, education and training, small business ideas and loans, spiritual guidance, bible studies, prayer groups and so much more. With the generous donation from all of you, we were able to break ground and complete the very first stage by hiring locals to dig and lay the foundation for the wall around the property (approx. 1000sq meters). Our prayer is to build a small team house for future mission volunteers/leadership housing and a community center that will be a place to shine God's love and share Jesus' name for the people of Maplat. With the few donations that we have received towards this, we have already been able to start making changes for

the people of Maplat. Here's a short story from Nego's recent trip: As we held a free medical clinic for Maplat while laying the foundation, the medical crew came across a family who's 3 children all suffered from bad Asthma. The two oldest could hardly catch a breath as they had one attack after another even in front of the doctor. With the generous donations from some of you at Westside, we bought the necessary puffers and gave them to the boys who finally caught their breathe and smiled. With such a small thing like this, we know that bringing in a permanent solution will not only uplift the opression in this area but literally save lives. Stage 2 is coming up fast and with your help we can build the wall that will secure the property.

To continue on this journey for change we would like to ask if you, our Christian family, would prayerfully consider donating towards the the overall goal of building this compound for change!

Stage 2 funds needed: We invite you to help out with the second stage of construction which is to build the security wall around the property. An easy way to help is by buying blocks needed in order to complete the wall. Currently we need 2,240 blocks to finish. We currently already have 1,260 blocks made from our extra 30 bags of cement leftover from the foundation. To make each block it costs \$1.50. For example ;if you were to buy 50 it would cost \$75, 100 \$150 or even 300 \$450. Help us by buying however many blocks you can to complete this 2nd stage for Maplat.
